Tay Trail/Midland Loop July 4th, 2023

A and B Rides : Meet at 8.45 am behind Tim's on 1st Street. At 9 am we will proceed to Midland and cross Hwy 12 to William St. Turn left and drive to the foot of William St. where you will see a row of blue & white waterfront townhouses. Turn into the townhouses and make an immediate left into a park parking lot. Parking is free. Driving time 60 minutes. (Enter 155 William St, Midland into your GPS) There is portable toilet.

A Ride - 50 K

We will ride with the B group on the paved waterfront trail and then split off and ride through the countryside in a clockwise loop which will take us back to the waterfront trail, past our cars, to the harbour. Recommended for road bikes.

We will head back to the Tay Trail, and east to a waterfront park at Victoria Harbour for a rest and water break before heading back along the trail to Midland's Harbour.
