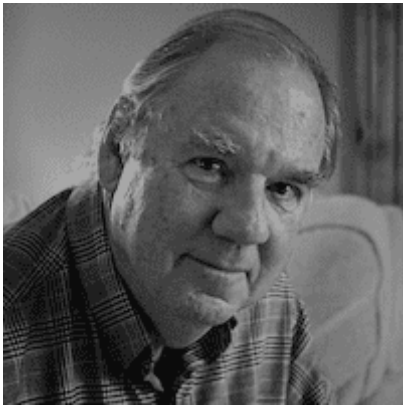


A note from the Webmaster
