## Paddle beautiful Lake Eugenia June 22<sup>nd</sup> 2023

The paddling trip will take about 2 hours to circumnavigate the beautiful historic lake and view the Eugenia power house and dam. The excursion will start and end at Dick Browns cottage followed by a BBQ lunch. A contribution of \$10 will be requested for each person staying for the lunch and volunteers for setting up, cooking and clean up will be much appreciated.

Fishers Note: If you bring your own fishing equipment there may be a chance to fish on the lake after lunch.
